Dear Steve:

It is with great pleasure that I write this letter in support of you and Rose Metal Systems efforts with regards to the Chesapeake Energy project Phase 2 and 3 in Sayre, PA. From day one I knew that my past experience working with you personally and other members of the Rose team would result in an outstanding project. We greatly appreciate your efforts to furnish and erect several building systems.

The unique requirements for these buildings included 35 foot eave heights, clear span framing and top running 20 ton crane systems. Multiple point loads, roof curbs and specialized wall framed openings challenged all of us to plan correctly from the start. Additional accessories including partition walls, mezzanines, liner panel and snow retention added to the challenge. Integrated office space required straight columns in phase 2 with limited column depths and high R roof insulation.

The fast track nature of this project and the remote location in Bradford County demanded pre-planning. Your willingness to travel to West Virginia to meet directly with the Architect and review the shop drawings proved invaluable. Many detailed issues were addressed prior to the steel arriving on site and this allowed your erection crews to move aggressively through the steel erection phase of the project.

Thanks again to you and all of your Rose Metal team members for leading the way on an outstanding Pre-engineered metal building project.
